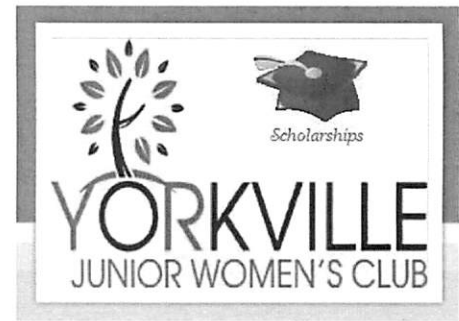


YJWC VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Please include a brief essay, one paragraph to no more than one page. Describe why you are applying for this scholarship and highlight your goals and how they are related to your degree/certificate. Be sure to highlight any community service and philanthropy. If additional space is needed for the application, please use additional paper.

Please submit to YHS Guidance / IVVC Office no later than Friday, April 3, 2020.

Once the applications have been received, a committee will review all applications and letters of recommendation along with your high school transcript. Although grades are a consideration, they are not our main focus. We are a service organization at heart, and thus will be looking for candidates who have been involved in the community. We strongly encourage that all activities be verified by the organization's representative when possible. We will narrow our selection to interview a few candidates. The final decision will be based on the information provided as well as the interview. The scholarships we choose to award will be announced at the awards ceremony at the end of the school year.
