Assistant Director Report

Mrs. Alyx Bickel reported on:

- IVVC has 18 registration request for 2025-2026 school year as follows: Auto Tech (3rd Session) 1, Welding & Fab (3rd Session) 3, Certified Nurse Assistant 1, Health Occupations 3, Sports Medicine 1, Fire Science 7 and Cosmetology 2.
- IVVC has received a total of \$46,884.00 in various grants during the 2024-2025 school vear.
- The Annual Reports data for the College and Career Readiness Indicator, IVVC published three reports, as completion of industry credential, dual credit, and career development experience are each career ready indicators. The information will be sent electronically to the person in your district who enters it into SIS. For the 24-25 Dual Credit, we have a total of 172 students who received 926 credit hours total. For the 24-25 Career Development Experiences, we have a total of 49 students. For the 24-25 Industry Credentials, we have a total of 501 students with a total of 817 credentials.

Administrative Cost Billing

Executive Committee

Mr. Joe Barbic explained that the committee met on June 2, 2025 discussing non joint agreement enrollment, the google shared drive, Construction Trades house, new construction lot, and the non certified staff.

Board of Control Shared Drive

Mr. Joe Barbic explained that the Board of Control Shared Drive will be a central location for board members to house information for them to access.

Other State Programs funding to VALEES

Mr. Barbic explained that in May of FY25, ISBE awarded an additional \$40,418 in Other State Programs funding to VALEES for Work-Based Learning activities targeted to rural students. This funding went 100% to IVVC as we serve the rural school districts within the VALEES region. IVVC used these funds to purchase a new Hunter alignment machine for automotive technology and a CNA simulation platform for the CNA program.

Clean Energy Career Pathway Grant - DCEO

Mr. Joe Barbic shared that on May 29, 2025 IVVC received the Notice of Grant Award from the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity. The full funding of \$482,779 has been confirmed. We were one of two grantees statewide. A couple of highlights for equipment and supplies we will receive: F150 Ford Lightning (all electric) with charging station, all expenses for training of our two IVVC auto instructors for EV safety, allTech Electrical trainers, vehicle lift and installation to accommodate electric vehicles, all safety tools associated for EV Safety curriculum, Toyota Camry Hybrid Vehicle - \$29,000, ACDC Trainer, van to transport students for Work-Based Learning, funding for middle school EV camp, and LED Lighting upgrade to shop. This will provide opportunities for the automotive technology along with affording IVVC students with dual credit from Waubonsee Community College and funds the EV safety credential for two years.
